

## **ADR and DGSA COURSES** **2010 TRAINING DATES**

### **Also bespoke courses available at your company premises**

Drivers of **all** vehicles carrying dangerous goods in scope of the regulations after 1 January 2007 must be trained and hold a vocational training certificate issued by DVLA. This is required by UK regulations implementing the relevant EU directives.

Courses must be approved by DFT and drivers must pass the SQA examinations which are integrated within the courses. There are no 'grandfather rights'.

Compulsory refresher training must be completed within the five year validity period of the certificate. Candidates should be entered on courses at least 12 weeks before expiry of a current certificate to minimise risk of a gap in continuity.

The maximum number of delegates per course is 16. Courses may be run at your own premises, (phone for a quote).

In addition, the regulations state that drivers carrying limited quantities, and any staff involved in the handling of movement of Hazardous materials, are required to have Hazardous Awareness Training.
